The Gibsons & District Library Foundation was established in November 2001 as a registered charity (No. 871892311 RR0001) in order to:

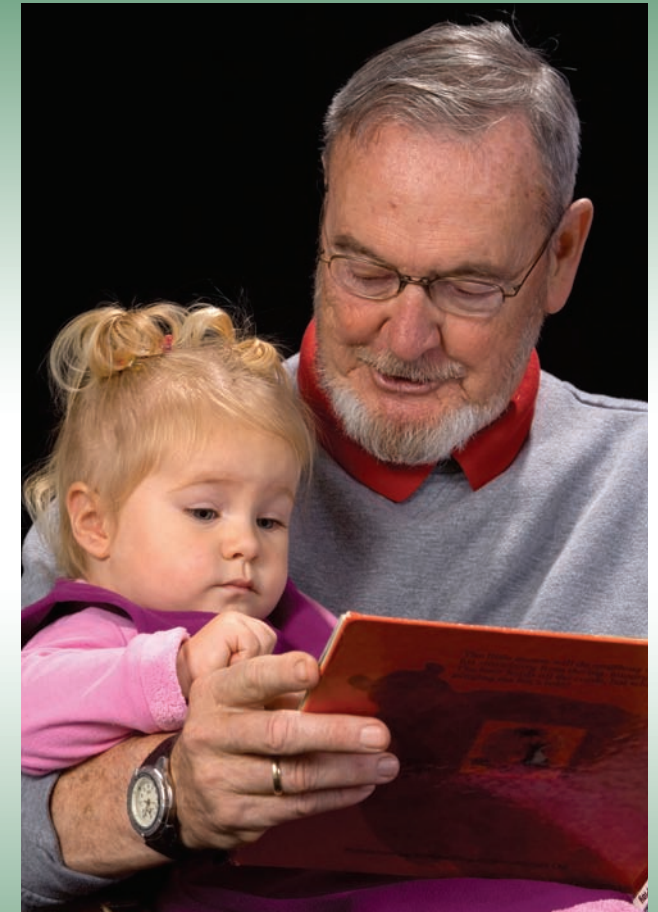
- Provide financial security to the Library, above and beyond government core funding, through the support of individuals and organizations.

Your publicly traded investments can become "in-kind" donations. Note that taxation legislation on in-kind donations changed effective May 2, 2006. Now when you donate stocks, bonds or mutual funds, the capital gains on them will not be taxed.
